The academic program at SHS is a traditional 8 period day. Semester class choices are available. Students are able to earn 3.5 credits per semester. We currently do not offer any AP courses; however, we do offer a variety of post secondary track classes:

- Certified Nursing Assistant (CNA) via Career Center of Southern Illinois
- Building Trades, dual credit courses via SWIC
- Students are able to enroll in Running Start - Dual HS Diploma / Associate's Degree program via SWIC
- Co-Op work program during senior year
